New Summer Worship:

Created to Be

As the seasons change from Winter to Spring and soon to Summer, we are also experiencing some changes here at Sharon. A new season dawns upon us. We have been working on some structural changes to our staff including votes to call Deacon Jamie Travers as our new Lead Rostered Minister and myself, Pastor Tawanda Murinda as the new Associate Rostered Minister. This summer, we will transition to a new staffing model which will see adjustments to responsibilities for all our staff members. Indeed, a new season is coming for our church!

As we make these changes to our staff, we feel inspired by the Holy Spirit to try something different for our summer worship. And so, starting on Memorial Day weekend, we will be living into a new worship schedule and service.

While the times will remain the same at 9:00 AM and 10:30 AM, we will drop one service at 9 AM to have two services on Sunday mornings, one at 9 and one at 10:30. We will also be



alternating worship spaces weekly between the Sanctuary and Celebration Hall. One week will be in the Sanctuary and the next week will be in Celebration Hall. Wednesdays will remain at 6:00 PM in Celebration Hall.

One more thing: because we are bringing our worship communities together this summer, our worship experience (style, liturgy, order, music) will also be different. We will try something new-but-familiar. We will lean into our Lutheran roots and embrace the things we love about our worship here at Sha-


