Summer Stewardship 2025

The Baobab tree is an iconic tree species found in Africa. It is widely distributed across the continent and has special sig-

nificance in African folklore and legend. Baobabs are long-lived deciduous small to large trees from 20 to 100 ft tall with broad trunks and compact crowns, and they can live to be thousands of years old. Tree diameter fluctuates with rainfall so that water may be stored in the trunk. The baobab's resilience and long life is reflected in its ability to store up to 1,000 liters of water in its trunk.

This symbolic tree also provided a guide as we provided contributions to Sharon Lutheran to support our programming during the summer months. Our total amount raised was \$4,965 for the summer. Thanks for all of your contributions!
