

On October 4, 2025, Yehiel Curry was installed as Presiding Bishop of our churchwide organization—the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Bishop Curry was elected during the ELCA Churchwide Assembly last summer.

Before his election as Presiding Bishop, he had

served as bishop of the Metropolitan Chicago Synod. Bishop Curry succeeds Bishop Elizabeth Eaton, who served as ELCA's presiding bishop for twelve years.
