





Description of Ministry Teams

Community Connections Team - Heightens congregational awareness of societal issues and provides an avenue for members to address these issues.

Education Team - Plans, administers, directs, and supervises the total educational program of the congregation.

Fellowship Team - Strengthens the fellowship between the members of our church, both spiritually and socially.

Properties Team - Assures the proper maintenance and repair of church property, and ensures general protection of the congregation against loss or damage of whatever nature.

Stewardship Team - Develops effective stewardship within the congregation around faithful giving and service.

Sharon Cares Team- Helps the church stay connected to those members who are unable to attend Sharon and its activities, have experienced a death in their family, and/or are experiencing health concerns. The team also provides staff recognition and thank yous, supports the transportation ministry and the hands up ministry.

Youth Ministry Team - Involve the young people of the congregation in the work of Christ, provide for their spiritual growth and nurture, and promote genuine Christian fellowship for the young people of the congregation.

Outreach Team—The Outreach Team works to build connections between our church, our members, and our community; with the goal of providing opportunities for everyone to know and experience the love of Jesus.

Worship Team—The Worship Ministry Team is responsible for the supervision of the entirety of congregational worship.
