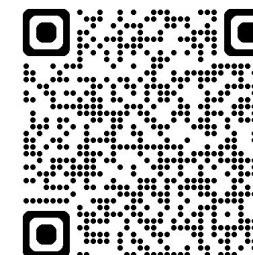


4th Annual Chili Cookoff

Community Connections Team **Collecting Items for LWR**

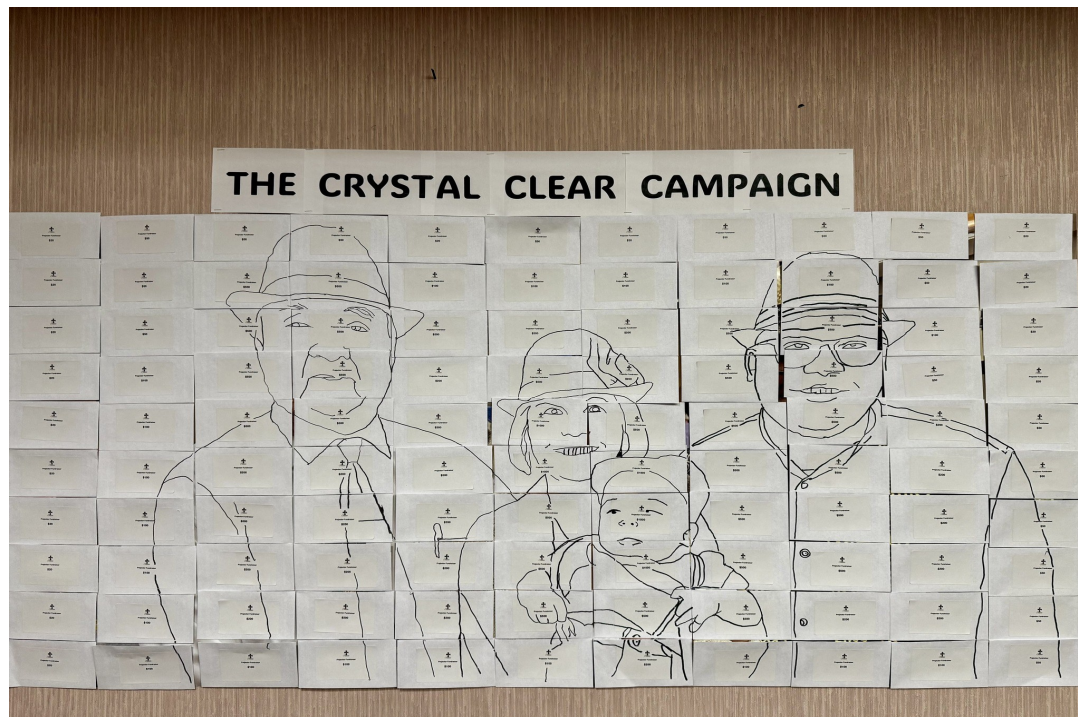
