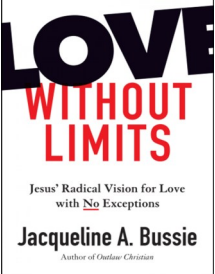

Summer Stewardship 2025

In many African cultures, the Baobab is seen as a source of life, providing food, shelter, medicine, and even water. Like the Baobab Tree, the church is a gathering place for all of God’s children and a place of shelter, comfort, support and community. At church we gather for community around Jesus Christ. We gather for communion. During these summer months, please help us sustain the ministry and gathering space at Sharon Lutheran.

We will use a depiction of the tree provided for Vacation Bible School (in the narthex). We will measure our progress toward our goal by providing water colored (blue) indicators as we reach \$1,000 levels of the goal (\$8,000). This symbolic tree also provides a guide as we provide contributions to Sharon Lutheran to support our programming during the summer months. Our drive will end on **September 28th**.
